## MCA / MSU Graded / Vaccinated Feeder Calf Sale *2009 Participation Agreement*

I am consigning \_\_\_\_\_ head of cattle (please fill in number of head) to the 2009 Michigan Cattlemen's Association (MCA) Graded / Vaccinated Feeder Calf Sale, and that upon vaccination of the cattle consigned, I agree to market these cattle through the MCA sale. Furthermore, I understand that, barring extenuating circumstances over which I have limited control (death or severe injury of cattle), if I choose not to market these cattle via the MCA sale, I will forego the application fee of \$4/head to be paid by October 1. I also understand that if I choose not to market these cattle via the MCA sale, I will be liable for \$10.00 per head, due to the MCA, as reimbursement for supplies and services provided as a benefit to consignors of the MCA sale. I also understand that all cattle sold in the MCA sale are subject to approval by the MCA appointed Graders. Consignors will have two options for any cattle deemed unfit for sale (due to illness, injury or non-compliance with preconditioning requirements). Consignors may 1) remove animal(s) from sale yard premises on the day prior to, or the day of the sale, or 2) cattle will be held over at the sale yards until the next regularly scheduled sale at that yard, at which time the animal(s) will be sold. The MCA and the sale yard assumes no responsibility for animal well-being. Consignors assume responsibility for any and all charges (including yardage) incurred during the period of time from calf delivery to the yard until sale of animal(s). Furthermore I understand and accept that I will be responsible for any and all program costs: \$15/head (which includes the application fee mentioned above), and that these costs do not include the cost of vaccines necessary to fulfill the preconditioning protocol.
